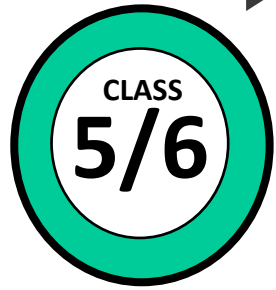

Textiles, weaving –Weaving artist Anni Albers and Chris Ofili – No Woman No Cry painting Year B

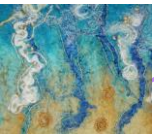


**Rocks, Relics and Rumbles**

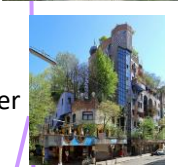
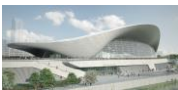

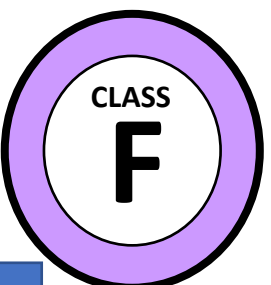


**Sunshine and Sunflowers**
